New Hampshire Cookbooks

In July 2018, in preparation for the 2019 Route One Reads summer reading road trip project, we asked NH librarians to recommend NH cookbooks. We asked that they be very specific to the state, not regional, and should ideally be widely available. Local community cookbooks and fundraising cookbooks from local organizations were not included in our call for suggestions as they are often difficult to get outside the community in which they are created. A few snuck into the list anyway. Various cookbooks by NH residents were suggested, including many by Mary Ann Esposito, but if the book was not specific to New Hampshire (even broadly interpreted) it was not included here. Note that many of these titles are out of print but may be available at your local library. Call numbers are noted for titles held by the NH State Library.
