Map Description
This map shows the changes in flood zone delineations between the current effective maps (dated May 17, 2005) and the preliminary maps (dated April 9, 2014). Changes may be a result of several factors, including enhanced coastal modeling techniques, new Zone AE/Zone A modeling, and/or improved delineations resulting from more accurate topographic data. Acreages corresponding to the mapped changes are presented in the table below.
