

How to Compare Preliminary and Effective FEMA Flood Map Information

Step 1: Go To

Step 2: Search for an address and/or community name and state.

Geoprocessing

To print Map Changes report:

- 1) Click the pin tool below.
- 2) Click a point on the map to select location.
- 3) Press Execute to receive a comparison report at 1in = 500ft scale for the selected location.

The process may take up to one minute.*

Step 3: Click the pin tool and then click the location on the map you're interested in.

Step 4: Click on the Execute button.

Geoprocessing

To print Map Changes report:

- 1) Click the pin tool below.
- 2) Click a point on the map to select location.
- 3) Press Execute to receive a comparison report at 1in = 500ft scale for the selected location.
