








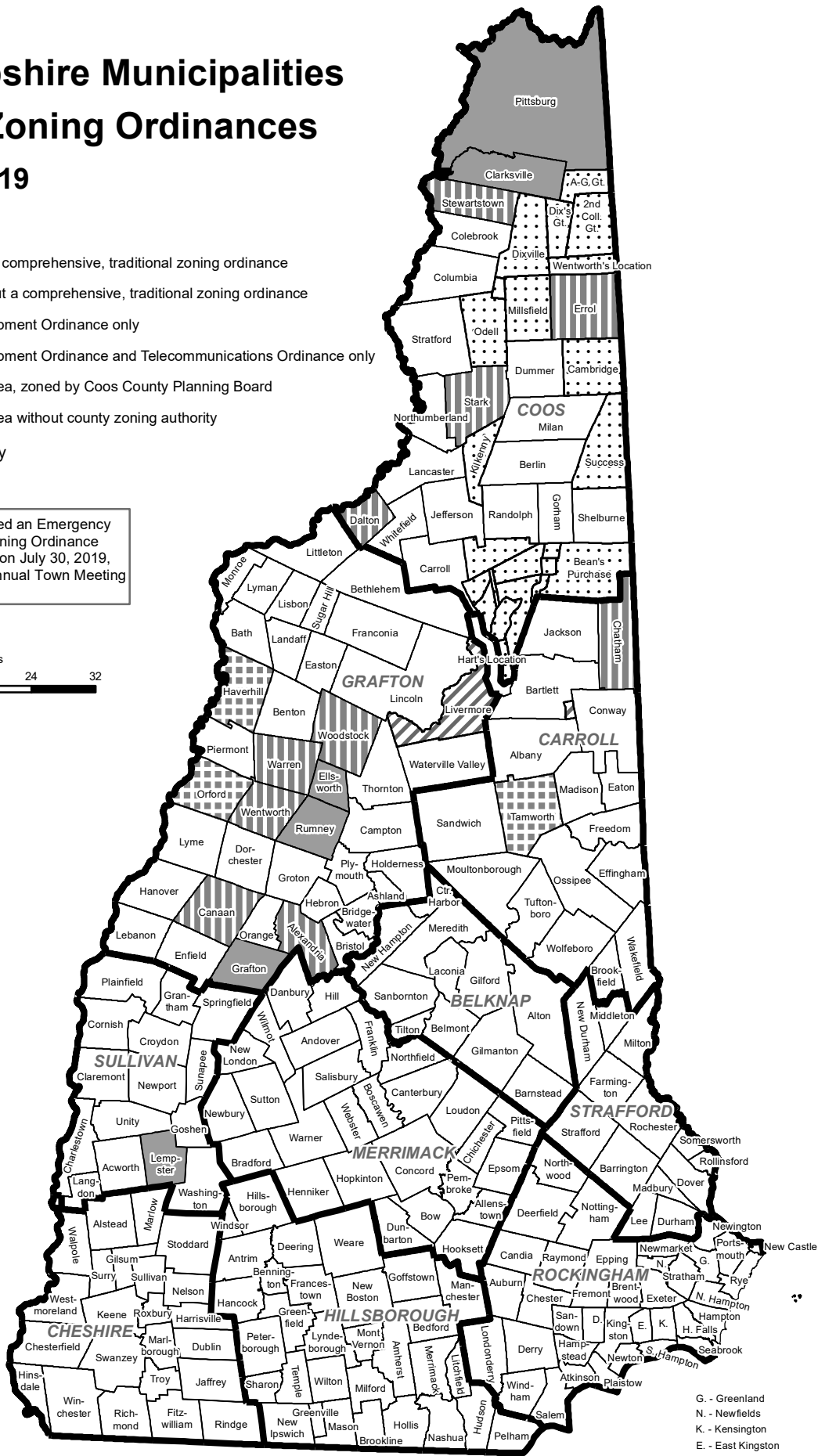
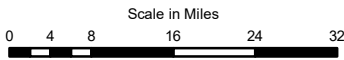
# New Hampshire Municipalities Status of Zoning Ordinances

-  Unincorporated area, zoned by Coos County Planning Board
-  Unincorporated area without county zoning authority
-  County boundary
