Wednesday	February 9, 2022	Last day to accept petitioned zoning amendments ( <a href="#">675:4</a> )
March 2022		
Thursday	March 3, 2022	Last day to post and publish for first public hearing on proposed zoning amendments, if a second hearing is anticipated ( <a href="#">675:3</a> ; <a href="#">675:7</a> )
Monday	March 14, 2022	Last day to hold first public hearing on proposed zoning amendments, if a second hearing is anticipated ( <a href="#">675:3</a> )
Thursday	March 18, 2022	Last day to post and publish for last hearing for proposed zoning amendments to be held on March 28, 2022 ( <a href="#">675:7</a> )
Monday	March 28, 2022*	Last day for final public hearing on proposed zoning amendments. Planning board must determine final form of zoning amendments to be posted in final warrant, which must be posted and filed with the town clerk ( <a href="#">675:3</a> )
April 2022		
Saturday	April 2, 2022	Earliest date to hold First Session of annual meeting. Governing body sets the date ( <a href="#">40:13,III</a> )
Tuesday	April 5, 2022	Last day for official copy of final proposed amendments to be placed on file at town clerk’s office ( <a href="#">675:3</a> )
Saturday	April 9, 2022	Last day to hold First session of annual meeting ( <a href="#">40:13,III</a> )
May 2022		
Tuesday	May 3, 2022	Last day to submit zoning ordinance protest petition to require 2/3 vote at town meeting ( <a href="#">675:5</a> ; <a href="#">40:13,VII</a> )
Tuesday	May 10, 2022	Second Session of annual meeting to elect officers, vote on questions on official ballot, and warrant articles from First Session of annual meeting ( <a href="#">40:13, VII</a> )

*\*It is strongly recommended the public hearings for zoning amendments are completed before this date.*
