Offshore wind energy is the use of wind farms constructed in the ocean, to harvest wind energy to generate electricity. Higher wind speeds are available offshore compared to on land, which makes this technology a potential fit to generate clean electricity for New Hampshire. There are potential impacts to existing offshore uses, ocean habitats, and maritime activities that will be studied further.
