Modification of Certified Bargaining Unit

Pursuant to RSA 273-A and PELRB Decision No. 2023-210 granting the City's petition for modification, the existing certification, set forth in PELRB Certification of Representative and Order to Negotiate, Case No. F-0101 (June 24, 1977), is amended; and it is hereby ordered that the composition of the modified bargaining unit, represented by the International Association of Fire Fighters, Local #1045 for purposes of collective negotiations and settlement of grievances, is as follows:

Unit: Firefighters/EMT, Firefighters/Paramedics, Firefighters/AEMTS, Fire Alarm Operators, Lead Fire Alarm Operators, and Fire Alarm/Traffic Signal Technicians.

The City of Concord shall negotiate with the International Association of Fire Fighters, Local #1045 as exclusive representative on the terms and conditions of employment for the members of the bargaining unit and shall recognize the right of the International Association of Fire Fighters, Local #1045 to represent employees in the settlement of grievances.
