Modification of Certified Bargaining Unit

Pursuant to RSA 273-A and PELRB Decision No. 2022-164 granting the Union's petition for modification, the existing certification, set forth in PELRB Certification and Order to Negotiate, Case No. A-0434 (March 17, 1978), is amended; and it is hereby ordered that the composition of the modified bargaining unit, represented by the AFSCME for purposes of collective negotiations and settlement of grievances, is as follows:

Unit: Equipment Operators, Laborers, Mechanics, Parking Enforcement, Recycling Attendants, Scale Attendants, and Truck Drivers.

Excluded: Foreman, and part-time and seasonal employees.

The Town of Conway shall negotiate with the AFSCME as exclusive representative on the terms and conditions of employment for the members of the bargaining unit and shall recognize the right of AFSCME to represent employees in the settlement of grievances.
