## Modification of Certified Bargaining Unit

Pursuant to RSA 273-A and PELRB Decision No. 2023-123, the bargaining unit described in PELRB Decision No. 2016-088 (April 27, 2016) is modified to reflect the changes noted in Decision No. 2023-123. Accordingly, the bargaining unit represented by the Derry Education Association/NEA-NH for purposes of collective negotiations and settlement of grievances is as follows:

Unit:

Teachers, Guidance Counselors, Speech Therapists, Librarians, School Nurses, Occupational Therapists, Physical Therapists, Speech Language Pathologists, School Psychologists, Specialist in Assessment of Intellectual Functioning (SAIF), Occupational Therapy Assistants, Physical Therapy Assistants, and Home to School Coordinators.

Excluded:

The Superintendent, Assistant Superintendents, Principals, full-time Assistant Principals, Directors, Psychologist Coordinator, Pre-School Coordinator, and all non-professional employees.

The Derry School District shall negotiate with bargaining unit exclusive representative Derry Education Association/NEA-NH on the terms and conditions of employment for bargaining unit employees and shall recognize the right of the exclusive representative to represent bargaining unit employees in the settlement of grievances.
