A representation proceeding having been conducted in the above matter by the Public Employee Labor Relations Board in accordance with RSA 273-A, Section 10 and the Rules and Regulations of the Board, and it appearing that a negotiating representative has been selected;


Pursuant to the authority vested in the Board by the Public Employee Labor Relations Act, and after the conduct of a representation election,

IT IS HEREBY CERTIFIED that the Durham Professional Municipal Managers Association has been designated and selected by a majority of the employees of the above named Public Employer, in the unit described below, as their representative for the purpose of collective negotiations and the settlement of grievances.

UNIT: Office Manager, Superintendent of Highways, Superintendent of Water and Solid Waste, Superintendent of Buildings and Grounds, Superintendent of Waste Water, Waste Water Lab Technician, Captains in the Police Department, Assistant Fire Chief, Deputy Fire Chief, Captains in the Fire Department and Administrative Assistant.

Further, IT IS ORDERED that the above named Public Employer shall negotiate collectively with the Durham Professional Municipal Managers Association with an objective to reaching an agreement with the employee organization on terms and conditions of employment, and shall negotiate collectively with such employee organization in the determination of, and administration of, grievances.
