CERTIFICATION OF REPRESENTATIVE AND ORDER TO NEGOTIATE

Pursuant to the authority vested in the Board by the Public Employee Labor Relations Act, (RSA 273-A) and in accordance RSA 273-A:10 and Pub 303, IT IS HEREBY CERTIFIED that the NEPBA Local 28, IUPA, AFL-CIO, Epping Police Union has been designated and selected by a majority of the employees of the above named public employer, in the unit described below, as their representative for purposes of collective negotiations and settlement of grievances.

UNIT: All full-time and regular part-time Patrol Officers and Corporals employed in the Town's Police Department. EXCLUDED: Sergeant. CONFIDENTIAL: Secretary to Chief.

Further, IT IS ORDERED that the above named public employer shall negotiate collectively with the exclusive representative named herein on terms and conditions of employment for the members of the bargaining unit, as herein described, and shall recognize the right of such exclusive representative to represent employees in the settlement of grievances.
