MODIFICATION ORDER

Pursuant to RSA 273-A and PELRB Decision No. 2014-165 granting the District's petition for modification, the bargaining unit description, set forth in PELRB Certification of Representative and Order to Negotiate, Case No. A-0570 (June 2, 1993), is amended; and it is hereby ordered that the composition of the modified bargaining unit, represented by the AFSCME Local 1906, Council 93, AFL-CIO for purposes of collective negotiations and settlement of grievances, is as follows.

**Unit:** Permanent full time Principals, Assistant Principals, School Counselors, Dean of Academics, Department Heads, Media Specialists, School Psychologist, Directors of School Counseling, Athletics, Career and Technical Education, and Music, Transition Coordinator, K-12 and the Community and Business Liaison.

**Excluded:** Superintendent of Schools, Assistant Superintendent of Schools, Director of Special Services, Business Administrator, and all other employees of the District.

The above named public employer shall negotiate with the exclusive representative named herein on terms and conditions of employment for the members of the bargaining unit, as herein described, and shall recognize the right of the exclusive representative to represent employees in the settlement of grievances.
