
SUBJECT: Re-Hearing on Rescission of Certification of the White Mountains Education Association, NHEA/NEA

On a Motion for Re-Hearing filed on June 3, 1976 by Jack B. Middleton, Attorney for the White Mountains Education Association, the Public Employee Labor Relations Board held a re-hearing on the rescission of certification at 9:30 a.m., Wednesday, June 16, 1976, in Room 306 of the Legislative Office Building, Concord, New Hampshire.

It was noted that an "Opposition to Motion for Re-Hearing" was filed by Bradley F. Kidder, Attorney, representing the White Mountains School District with PELRB on June 8, 1976.

After considering further evidence and testimonies, the Public Employee Labor Relations Board reaffirmed its decision of May 12, 1976 to rescind the certification of the White Mountains Education Association on the basis that the document submitted was not a complete contract.
