## ORDER DENYING PETITION

## FOR REHEARING

On July 31, 1980, we entered a decision wherein we stated that the Public Practice Professional Association had complied with the requirements of RSA 273-A and were entitled to an election to determine if the multi-disciplinary medical and dental service employees of the New Hampshire Hospital, which include psychiatrists, neurologists, dentists and physicians, wish to be represented in collective bargaining by the Association.

Pursuant to an election held on September 19, 1980, which resulted in a 13 to 1 vote in favor of the Association, the Board certified the Public Practice Professional Association as the exclusive representative.

Since the granting of a rehearing is a discretionary matter, we carefully reviewed the case and have determined that no basis exists for the reconsideration of our previous decision.

We therefore

ORDER that the Public Practice Professional Association is recognized as the exclusive bargaining agent for a bargaining unit composed of the psychiatrists, neurologists, dentists and physicians employed by the State of New Hampshire, and,

FURTHER ORDER that the petition for rehearing is denied.
