ORDER DENYING PETITION

FOR REHEARING

On October 17, 1983, PELRB entered into a unanimous decision wherein it ordered S.A.U. 21's Joint Boards Negotiating Team and its Agents to begin negotiations immediately with the Seacoast Educational Support Personnel Association.

Counsel for the Team on November 9, 1983 filed a "Motion to Stay. Order to Negotiate Pending Appeal" along with a "Motion for Rehearing".

Counsel for SESPA on November 21, 1983 filed a Memorandum in Opposition to Respondents' Motion for Rehearing.

As the granting of a rehearing is a discretionary matter, the Board at its meeting, January 5, 1984, reviewed the submissions from both Counsels and determined that all issues had been discussed and ruled on at the orginal hearing.

PELRB therefore

ORDERS that the motion for stay and rehearing be, and hereby is denied.
