## ORDER DENYING PETITION

## FOR REHEARING

On April 12, 1984, PELRB entered into a unanimous decision whereby it reaffirmed its decisions 81-35 and 84-04 and found that the President of the Association was within his rights, under RSA 273-A, in meeting with his Association representative, and ordered the letter of reprimand removed from the President's personnel file. Further, PELRB ordered the School Board and the Association to cooperate in facilitating access of the Association's representative to teachers when they were not engaged in actual teaching and cautioned the Association about disruption of the educational mission of the school.

Counsel for the School Board on April 24, 1984 petitioned for a rehearing in the matter citing PELRB's failure to specifically respond to the respondents' requests for finding of facts and rulings dated February 2, 1984 and failure to clarify the term "actually engaged in teaching".

After reviewing the petition for rehearing and discussing the original hearing, PELRB members were unanimous in their opinion that the petition be, and hereby is, denied and that the Haverhill Cooperative School Board and its Superintendent, Norman H. Mullen, abide by its decision No. 84-27 issued on April 12, 1984.
