ORDER DENYING PETITION

FOR REHEARING

On September 14, 1984, PELRB determined that a unit composed of secretaries, lunchworkers and aides in the Sanborn Regional School District was an appropriate unit and ordered an election prior to October 3, 1984.

An election was held on October 2, 1984 resulting in a 21 to 2 vote in favor of the Sanborn Regional Support Staff, Affiliated with Sanborn Regional Education Association, NEA-New Hampshire as the exclusive representative and certification issued as of that date.

Motion for rehearing was filed by Counsel for the School District on October 2, 1984 on the basis of the community of interest of "all" eligible employees of the Support Staff and their earlier requests for findings of fact and rulings of law. The certified representative objected to the motion.

PELRB in its review of the case determined that all evidence was presented at the original hearing and that the unit, as certified, is an appropriate unit.

PELRB ORDERS that the motion for rehearing be, and hereby is, denied.
