

ORDER DENYING PETITION
FOR REHEARING

PELRB entered a decision in the above case which found that the management rights clause did not override Article XVI, Section D of the original agreement and that the institution of time slips was within the "managerial prerogative" of the employer; found the School Board guilty of a violation of RSA 273-A:5, I(e) and ordered the Board to return to the use of individual contracts which were in use prior to July of 1981.

Counsel for the School Board filed for rehearing stating that in depriving the School Board of the benefit of its bargain obtained through the negotiation process, the decision of PELRB was unreasonable, unjust and unlawful and, requested a rehearing and reexamination of the contents of Article IV of the collective bargaining agreement.

The request lacking introduction of new evidence, PELRB ORDERS that the motion for rehearing be, and hereby is, denied.
