DECISION AND ORDER


The Dover Teachers' Union filed a "Request For an Immediate Cease and Desist Order and Enforcement of Existing Orders" to prohibit William H. McCann, Jr., Chief Spokesperson for the Dover School Committee from making unilateral statements of any kind to the press or in any public forum about the conduct of negotiations or any of the people involved.

A hearing on the request was held in the Board's office on August 25, 1987. After hearing arguments from the parties, the Board issued the following order:

ORDER

The Board declines to issue a temporary Cease and Desist Order as requested by the Teachers' Union pending a full hearing. However, the Board directs that any statements regarding scheduling of mediation be joint statements. Further the Board reminds the parties of its previous orders, regarding public comments regarding the subjects of negotiations, still in effect.
