DECISION & ORDER

AFSCME, Council 93 on June 25, 1987 petitioned for a proposed unit composed of sergeants and patrolmen in the Town of Chester.

The Town filed objections to the proposed unit on the basis that all officers were part-time special officers, or special officers employed irregularly or on call and that the unit did not meet the minimum requirement of ten under RSA 273-A:8, I (d).

A unit determination hearing was scheduled for September 3, 1987.


Representative for Council 93 on August 22, 1987 informed the Board that as a result of information just received, they requested withdrawal of the petition.
