ORDER DISMISSING COMPLAINT

Dover Teachers' Union, Local 3536, NHFT, AFT, AFL-CIO on July 31, 1987 filed prohibited practice charges against William H. McCann, Chairman of the Negotiating Committee and the Dover School Committee for press statements made by Mr. McCann in violation of PELRB Orders No. 87-22 & 22-A issued in March & April of '87, and continued refusal by the Committee to bargain in good faith with the Teachers' Union.

By letter dated September 12, 1987, representative of the Union advised that in consideration of a newly negotiated settlement with the School Committee, the Union desired withdrawal of the charges filed, therefore, it is

ORDERED that this complaint be and the same hereby is dismissed without prejudice.
