BACKGROUND

Petition for Declaratory Judgment and Cease and Desist Orders were filed by the Hopkinton School Board seeking a Stay of Arbitration pending a determination of the arbitrability of the issue in question.

Hearing on the request for Cease and Desist was convened on January 21, 1988 and resulted in the following agreement by and between the parties and unanimous acceptance by PELRB.

AGREEMENT

The parties agreed to waive presentation of evidence and further hearing on the Cease and Desist matter and agreed:

- 1. That the request for the Cease and Desist Order would be withdrawn.
- 2. The parties would proceed to the selection of an arbitrator.
- 3. The parties agreed that no date would be set for an arbitration hearing until at least 15 days from the receipt of a decision from PELRB on the merits of the Hopkinton School Board's petition and the Association's counter claim.
- 4. A hearing on the merits of the School Board's petition and the

Association's counter claim would be scheduled for 2:00 p.m., Thursday, February 18, 1988 in the PELRB office.

5. The parties' request for an early decision from PELRB was acknowledged.
