#### MOTION FOR REHEARING

PELRB on August 30, 1989 issued decision No. 89-57 ordering the parties to pursue final and binding interest arbitration in accordance with Sections 13.5 and 13.6 of the collective bargaining agreement by and between the parties.


The District filed a motion for reconsideration on several points; i.e., the decision failed to: (1) rule on the Association's charge regarding salary proposals, (2) rule on the District's claim that binding interest arbitrations is not a mandatory subject of bargaining, (3) address the City Charter amendment, (4) rule on the constitutionality of the District's delegation of authority to establish terms and conditions of employment to a binding interest arbitrator, and (5) erred when it found the binding interest arbitration clause valid.

PELRB reviewed all evidence presented at the original hearing, the Rockingham County Superior Court rulings and found no new evidence, or basis to merit reconsideration.

#### DECISION

The Motion for Rehearing is hereby DENIED.
