
MOTION FOR REHEARING

On August 30, 1989, the Dover Teachers' Union moved for rehearing in the above case wherein PELRB denied their petition to change affiliation and ordered a new petition for certification under the appropriate statutory provisions should the union so desire. (Decision No. 89-53)

A certification petition was filed in accordance with RSA 273-A:10 and the Board's Rules and Regulations Pub 303, election held on October 11, 1989 resulting in 174 to 9 vote in favor of the Dover Teachers' Union, NEA-New Hampshire, NEA and their certification as exclusive representative for all full-time and job sharing teachers including classroom teachers, guidance nurses, librarians, curriculum advisors' and federal projects personnel.

Issue in the Motion for Rehearing having been rendered Moot by the certification election, it is, therefore, ordered that the Motion be DENIED and case closed.
