## MOTION FOR REHEARING

On September 13, 1989, PELRB issued Decision No. 90-91 wherein the created a bargaining unit of all full-time and part-time patrolmen, clerk, secretary/dispatcher, field training officer and detective/sergeant in the Police Department, Town of Litchfield and ordered an election held as expeditiously as possible under RSA 273-A and the Board's Rules and Regulations.

Counsel for the Town motioned for reconsideration of the Board's decision again raising the supervisory issue relative to the detective/sergeant and the field training officer and the part-time officers lack of community of interest.

The Board in reviewing the Motion for Reconsideration and evidence at the hearing find that all issues were raised and fully discussed at the hearing held in June, 1990.

Finding no merit for reconsideration, the Board hereby DENIES the Motion for Rehearing and will proceed with the election under RSA 273-A.
