DECISION AND ORDER

The Board, meeting at its offices in Concord, New Hampshire, on October 13, 1992, took the following actions:

- 1. It accepted and ruled that the pending ULP was timely filed as of July 17, 1992, and that that date shall be construed as the timely filing date of the original grievance in this matter.
- 2. It directed that the parties should pursue that grievance through the grievance procedure found at Article 10 of the collective bargaining agreement.
- 3. It retained jurisdiction of this matter pending its resolution in accordance with Article 10 of the existing agreement.
- 4. It directed that the parties notify the PELRB within thirty (30) days of the completion of the processing of the grievance through the grievance procedure found at Article 10 of the contract. If neither party requests re-opening of this case within that thirty (30) day period, the case will thereafter be administratively dismissed from the Board's docket.
