DECISION AND ORDER

The Board, meeting at its offices in Concord, New Hampshire, on October 20, 1992, took the following actions:

- 1. It reviewed the Association's Unfair Labor Practice (ULP) complaint dated May 13, 1992 and the District's answer dated May 25, 1992 as well as the District's Motion to Dismiss of the same date on the basis of timeliness (RSA 273-A:6 VII)
- 2. It heard opening arguments by counsel for the parties on the issue of timeliness and determined that the ULP in this matter was filed more than six (6) months after the last actions taken by the District with respect to the Association's/ Grievant's complaint.
- 3. Thereupon, the ULP was DISMISSED.
