## DECISION AND ORDER

The Board, meeting at its offices in Concord, New Hampshire, on December 1, 1992, took the following actions:

- It reviewed the District's Petition for Declaratory 1. Judgment and Motion to Stay Arbitration filed August 17, 1992 as well as the Association's Answer and Objection to Motion to Stay Arbitration filed September 2, 1992.
- 2. It heard arguments by representatives of each side with respect to pending pleadings and motions.
- 3. It GRANTED the District's Motion to Stay Arbitration.
- 4. It GRANTED the Motion to Continue the case for hearing on the merits and directed the parties that then should notify the PELRB within thirty (30) days if they want to proceed with such a hearing. In the meantime, this case will be moved to the bottom of the PELRB's docket.
