MOTION TO STAY ARBITRATION

The Board, meeting at its offices in Concord, New Hampshire, on December 22, 1992, took the following actions:

- 1. It reviewed the Board's Unfair Labor Practices (ULP) complaint and its Motion to Stay Arbitration Proceedings, both filed November 25, 1992.
- 2. It reviewed the Association's response and counter-claim in the form of another ULP filed on December 10, 1992.
- 3. It reviewed the parties' collective bargaining agreement (CBA) which expired on June 30, 1991 and voted that any extension must have been "mutually agreed upon in writing by the parties." It found no such extension to have been agreed upon and, therefore, the grievance and arbitration provisions of the CBA to have expired.
- 4. It GRANTED the Motion to Stay Arbitration Proceedings and directed the consolidated ULP's to be docketed for hearing.
