## MOTION TO DISMISS

At that appointed time, the undersigned Hearing Officer opened the proceedings at 1:44 p.m. and requested the entry of appearances from the parties to these proceedings. That the Unfair Labor Practice Complaint be dismissed for failure to prosecute.
