

The Board, meeting at its offices in Concord, New Hampshire, on April 20, 1994, took the following actions:

1. It reviewed the District's Motion for Rehearing and/or clarification filed March 29, 1994, noting in particular, that the "clarifications" sought would materially affect the remedy provided in its Decision No. 94-18.
2. It reviewed the Association's objections to the to the District's motion as filed April 16, 1994.
3. It examined the Association's unfair labor practice complaint filed July 6, 1993 and the District's answer filed July 19, 1993, noting that no procedural defenses were asserted in that answer.
4. It reviewed its decision (Decision No. 94-18) in this matter dated March 10, 1994.
5. It DENIED the District's Motion for Rehearing/ Clarification.
