## MOTIONS TO INTERVENE - MOTION FOR REHEARING

The Board, meeting at its offices in Concord, New Hampshire, on July 19, 1994, took the following actions:

- It examined the following documents in the case, filed since Decision No. 94-19 was issued on May 20, 1994:
  - a) The Motion for Rehearing filed by the House Legislative Facilities Subcommittee (HLFS) on June 9, 1994;
  - b) The Petition for Intervention and Rehearing filed by the New Hampshire Senate (NHS) along with a supporting memorandum on June 9, 1994;
  - The response of the HLFS to the NHS Motions, as filed June 16, 1994;
  - d) The Petition for Intervention of Mark MacKenzie (PIMM) and Objections to Motions for Rehearing filed June 24, 1994;
  - e) The objection of Robert Cushing to the Motions filed by the NHS, as filed on

June 24, 1994;

- f) The HLFS Memorandum supporting rehearing filed June 24, 1994;
- g) The objections of the HLFS to the PIMM, as filed July 1, 1994;
- h) Robert Cushing's statement supporting PIMM, filed July 8, 1994; and
- i) Memorandum of Intervenor, United Auto Workers International Union, opposing HLFS Motion for Rehearing and NHS Motions for Intervention and Rehearing, as filed July 14, 1994
- Whereupon the Board GRANTED the following motions:
  - a) The Petition for Intervention of the NHS;
  - b) The Petition for Intervention of Mark MacKenzie; and
  - c) The Petition for Rehearing of the HLFS.
