MOTION FOR REHEARING

The Board, meeting at its offices in Concord, New Hampshire, on December 8, 1994, took the following actions:

- It reviewed the Motion for Rehearing and Appeal for Reconsideration filed by the International Brotherhood of Police Officers (IBPO) on November 3, 1994 which sought to vacate the amended certification issued by the PELRB on October 14, 1994 recognizing the Concord Police Patrolman's Association (CPPA) as the successor certified bargaining agent under the provisions of Rule Pub 301.05.
- It reviewed the objections of the Concord Police Patrolman's Association filed on November 18, 1994 which opposed further proceedings or hearings in this matter.
- 3. It examined the representations made in the CPPA's Petition for Change of Affiliation dated October 7, 1994 and found that they satisfied the requirements of Rule Pub 301.05.
- It noted that the City of Concord had no position of record on the matter of the challenged certification.

5. It DENIED the IBPO's Motion for Rehearing and Appeal for Reconsideration.
