MOTION FOR CONTINUANCE

The Board, meeting at its offices in Concord, New Hampshire, on December 13, 1994, took the following actions:

- It reviewed the Federation's unfair labor practice (ULP) complaint filed October 28, 1994 and the City's answer filed November 14, 1994.
- 2. It convened a hearing for purposes of hearing and disposing of the pending ULP charges.
- 3. It GRANTED the parties' joint motion for a continuance in these proceedings until January 13, 1995 so that they might have additional time to reach and ratify a settlement in their contract negotiations. If neither party has notified the PELRB of its desire for an additional hearing date in this matter on or before the close of business on January 13, 1995, it shall be administratively dismissed from the PELRB's docket of cases.
