MOTION FOR REHEARING

The Board, meeting at its offices in Concord, New Hampshire, on December 13, 1994, took the following actions:

- It reviewed the International Brotherhood of Police Officers' (IBPO) Motion for Rehearing filed August 29, 1994 and the Commission's objections thereto filed September 1, 1994.
- 2. It examined the unfair labor practice (ULP) complaint filed by the IBPO on May 23, 1994 and the Commission's answer filed on May 24, 1994.
- 3. It reviewed its decision (Decision No. 94-79) dated August 17, 1994 noting, in particular, that the decision denied relief for a testing cycle which had yet to occur and directed the parties to bargain the impact of the proposed reorganization.
- 4. It took notice that the IBPO's Motion for Rehearing, if granted, would apply to events alleged to have happened on or before the filing of the ULP on May 23, 1994, not since that date.

5. It DENIED the Motion for Rehearing.
