## ORDER CONSOLIDATING CASES FOR HEARING

The Board, meeting at its offices in Concord, New Hampshire, on January 19, 1995, took the following actions:

1. It examined the original unfair labor practice (ULP)

complaint filed by AFSCME on November 16, 1994 and answered by the City on November 28, 1994.

- 2. It examined the ULP charges filed by Manchester Education Association (MEA) and Manchester Education Support Personnel Association (MESPA) on December 19, 1994 and the City's answer thereto filed on January 3, 1995.
- 3. It examined the ULP charges filed by the United Steel Workers of America, Local 8938 (USWA) on December 15, 1994 and answered by the City on December 29, 1994.
- 4. It reviewed the motions of the MEA, the MESPA and the USWA to consolidate their ULP complaints with the AFSCME ULP complaint already scheduled for hearing on January 24, 1995, noting representations that AFSCME has concurred therewith and the City has not.
- 5. It determined that the issues for adjudication in each of the ULP cases as pled are identical.
- 6. It directed that the complaints be consolidated for hearing set for January 24, 1995 and that judicial economy would be served thereby.
