ORDER DISMISSING COMPLAINT


The International Chemical Workers Union (ICWU) filed unfair labor practice charges against Merrimack County Nursing Home (County) November 9, 1994. The County filed its answer on November 28, 1994. This matter was set for hearing before the Board on January 19, 1995. Prior to opening the record for testimony, a conference was held at which the County stated its objection to proceeding given that administrative remedies had yet to be exhausted. The ICWU stated it would not object a Motion to Dismiss so long as no prejudice accrued to the ICWU.

Upon opening the record, the Board accepted the County's Motion to Dismiss and granted the County's Motion to Dismiss without prejudice to the ICWU.

ORDERED the pending unfair labor practice charges hereby are DISMISSED without prejudice
