PETITION FOR REVIEW OF ARBITRATION AWARD'S CONSISTENCY WITH COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT AND MOTION TO STAY ARBITRATION AWARD

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The Board, meeting at its offices in Concord, New Hampshire, on February 14, 1995, took the following actions:

- It reviewed the Districts' Petition for Review of Arbitration Award's Consistency with Collective Bargaining Agreement and Motion to Stay Arbitration Award (herein after collectively "Motion") filed January 20, 1995 and the Association's objections thereto filed January 30, 1995 and February 10, 1995.
- 2. It examined the Association's unfair labor practice (ULP) complaint filed July 6, 1993 and the District's answer filed July 19, 1993 as well as its decision (Decision No. 94-18) dated March 10, 1994 which directed the parties to proceed to binding grievance arbitration under their collective bargaining agreement (CBA).
- 3. It reviewed the arbitrator's opinion and award for its independent analysis under the grievance arbitration provisions of the CBA, noting that it found and cited breaches of the CBA.

4. It DENIED the District's Motion for Review and Staying the arbitration award.

So ordered.
