#### MOTION TO CONTINUE


The parties, appearing before the undersigned hearing officer on September 7, 1995, agreed to the following disposition of Case No. A-0491:12 filed by the County against AFSCME on July 12, 1995:

1. The Union disclosed that it learned earlier in the morning that a key witness in this matter would not be available for the afternoon hearing as scheduled.
2. The Union moved to continue this matter for hearing at a later date.
3. The County concurred in that request.

There being consensus between the parties and no evidence of imminent danger or irreparable harm, the Motion to Continue is GRANTED, with this matter to be rescheduled for hearing after October 20, 1995.
