MOTION FOR RECONSIDERATION

The Board, meeting at its offices in Concord, New Hampshire, on October 26, 1995 took the following actions:

- It reviewed the County's Motion for Reconsideration 1. filed on September 18, 1995 and the Union's objections thereto filed on October 4, 1995.
- It examined the unfair labor practice (ULP) complaint 2. filed by the County on August 1, 1995 and the Union's answer and Motion to Dismiss filed August 15, 1995.
- 3. It reviewed its decision (Decision No. 95-77) dated September 15, 1995 in the form of granting the Union's Motion to Dismiss based on what had been represented to be a settlement of the underlying grievance which created the procedural issues about which the county complained in its ULP.
- 4. It affirmed its conclusion that the merits of the underlying case had been resolved by the parties and DENIED the County's Motion for Reconsideration.
