MOTION TO DEFER RULING ON MOTION FOR REHEARING


The Board, meeting at its offices in Concord, New Hampshire, on October 31, 1995, took the following actions:

1. It received and reviewed the Court System's Motion to Defer Ruling on Motion for Rehearing for 120 days as filed October 13, 1995 and the State Employees' Association letter filed October 27, 1995 agreeing to that deferral for a maximum of 120 days.
2. It noted that its underlying decision in this matter was dated September 15, 1995 (Decision No. 95-64) and that no irreparable harm was alleged or threatened as the result of granting the Court System's motion.
3. It GRANTED the Motion to Defer Ruling on Motion for Rehearing for 120 days. At the expiration thereof, either party may request the PELRB to proceed with ruling on the Motion for Rehearing. If no such request

is made between the 120th day and the 150th day from the date of this decision the Motion for Rehearing shall be dismissed from the PELRB's docket.
