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#### MOTION FOR REHEARING

The Board, meeting at its offices in Concord, New Hampshire, on November 14, 1995 took the following actions:

1. It reviewed the City's Motion for Rehearing filed October 24, 1995 and the Union's objections thereto filed November 8, 1995.
2. It examined the unfair labor practice (ULP) charges filed by the Union against the City on May 18, 1995; the City's response thereto filed June 2, 1995; the City's ULP charges against the Union filed July 27, 1995; and the Union's response thereto filed August 10, 1995. These matters were consolidated for hearing on August 15, 1995.

3. It reviewed its decision (Decision No. 95-90) in this matter dated October 4, 1995, affirming the arbitration process used by the parties and noting that the Motion for Rehearing presented no new evidence from what was available and presented to the PELRB at the original hearing on September 21, 1995.
4. It **DENIED** the Motion for Rehearing.
