ORDER DISMISSING ULP COMPLAINT AND COUNTER-CLAIM

The Board, meeting at its offices in Concord, New Hampshire, on December 12, 1995, took the following actions:

- 1. It reviewed the Association's unfair labor practice (ULP) complaint filed September 15, 1995, the Board's answer, cross-complaint and cross-petition for declaratory judgment filed October 2, 1995, and the Associations answer to cross-complaint filed October 13, 1995.
- 2. It convened a hearing to take evidence and hear testimony relating to the foregoing causes of action whereupon counsel for each party advised the PELRB that they had conferred and found a means of satisfactorily disposing of all pending causes of action.
- 3. It received motions from counsel for each party to withdraw their respective pending causes of action and GRANTED said motions, thus dismissing all pending matters relating to these proceedings.
