## MOTION TO DISMISS

The Board, meeting at its offices in Concord, New Hampshire, on December 18, 1995, took the following actions:

- It reviewed the Union's unfair labor practice (ULP) complaint filed November 9, 1995 and the City's answer filed November 22, 1995.
- It convened a hearing to take evidence and hear testimony relating to the pending ULP complaint.
- 3. It heard opening arguments from counsel for each party, was advised that the Union intended to call no witnesses and heard a closing, summary argument offered by the Union.
- 4. It accepted the City's Motion to Dismiss for failure to state and prove a claim of unfair labor practice and deliberated thereon.
- It GRANTED the City's Motion to Dismiss, without prejudice.
