



noticed to the Association under Article 3.2 of the collective bargaining agreement (CBA).

4. Thereafter, the PELRB disposed of the pending complaint based on the following circumstances and directives:
- a) The State waives assertion of time limits for the re-filing of this case.
  - b) The case is, therefore, dismissed without prejudice to its being refiled by the Association at a later time.
  - c) The parties shall exchange data on the identity, address, hours worked and other employment conditions of part-time employees within the next thirty (30) days.
  - d) Thereafter, they shall meet at least four (4) times to determine which of the part-time positions are agreed to be covered by the CBA.
  - e) These negotiations shall be completed by January 1, 1999. If neither side refiles the subject matter of the ULP on or before January 1, 1999, the State's waiver of time in which to refile the complaint shall be deemed to have expired.
