

ORDER DISMISSING COMPLAINT

This Board issued an Interim Order in this matter on April 22, 1999 (Decision No. 1999-036) directing, among other things, that the parties proceed to grievance arbitration in accordance with their collective bargaining agreement (CBA). On June 28, 1999 the City of Nashua filed a Motion to Dismiss the pending unfair labor practice (ULP) complaint, averring that the Union had not filed for arbitration as of June 25, 1999. The Union filed written objection to the City's Motion to Dismiss on July 13, 1999; however, by letter of August 17, 1999, and filed that same date, the Union withdrew its objection to the City's Motion to Dismiss. Accordingly, it is

ORDERED that the Union's unfair labor practice complaint be, and the same hereby is DISMISSED, without prejudice.
