ORDER TO CONTINUE

The Board, meeting at its officers in Concord, New Hampshire, on April 18, 2002, took the following actions:

1. It reviewed the Union's unfair labor practice (ULP) complaint filed on February 25, 2002, the Town's answer filed on March 12, 2002 and the Pre-hearing Decision and Order (Decision No. 2002-041) dated March 29, 2002 which set this matter for hearing before the PELRB on April 23, 2002.
2. It reviewed a joint motion to continue dated April 16, 2002 and subsequently filed with the PELRB on April 18th, 2002, seeking to have the April 23rd hearing date continued for thirty (30) days while the parties separately circulate and seek ratification of a settlement proposal which would obviate the need for a hearing in this matter and cause the pending ULP to be withdrawn by the Union.
3. It GRANTED the parties' joint motion to continue for a period of thirty (30) days ending on May 23, 2002. If neither party shall have requested further proceedings in this matter before the PELRB on or before May 23, 2002, the pending unfair labor practice complaint shall thereafter be administratively dismissed from the PELRB's docket of cases.
