
Pursuant to the authority vested in the Board by the Public Employee Labor Relations Act, and after the conduct of a representation election, IT IS HEREBY CERTIFIED that AFSCME LOCAL 2301, SEABROOK SUPERVISORY EMPLOYEES has been designated and selected by a majority of the employees of the above named Public Employer, in the unit described below, as their representative for the purpose of collective negotiations and the settlement of grievances.

UNIT: Assistant Recreation Dept. Director, Civil Defense Director, Deputy Town Clerk, Lieutenant Detective, Water Department Superintendent, Operations Lieutenant, Recreation Director, Welfare Officer, Deputy Town Treasurer, Code Enforcement Officer, Deputy Fire Chief, Deputy Police Chief, Chief Operator-Wastewater Treatment Plant, Part-time Assistant Code Enforcement Officer, Finance Manager and Recreation Program Director. EXCLUDED: Mosquito Control Director

Further, IT IS ORDERED that the above named Public Employer shall negotiate collectively with AFSCME LOCAL 2301, SEABROOK SUPERVISORY EMPLOYEES with an objective to reaching an agreement with the employee organization on terms and conditions of employment, and shall negotiate collectively with such employee organization in the determination, and administration of, grievances.
