CERTIFICATION OF REPRESENTATIVE AND ORDER TO NEGOTIATE


A representation proceeding having been conducted in the above matter by the Public Employee Labor Relations Board in accordance with RSA 273-A, Section 10 and the Rules and Regulations of the Board and it appearing that a negotiating representative has been selected.

Pursuant to the authority vested in the Board by the Public Employee Labor Relations Act, and after the conduct of a representation election, IT IS HEREBY CERTIFIED that the GILFORD EDUCATION ASSOCIATION/NEA-NH, has been designated and selected by a majority of the employees of the above named Public Employer, in the unit described below, as their representative for the purpose of collective negotiations and the settlement of grievances.

UNIT: "All teachers employed in the Gilford School District. The term "teachers" shall include any individual employed full-time or part-time by the Gilford School District whose position requires appropriate credentials issued by the State Board of Education under its regulations governing the certification of professional school personnel who spend less than fifty (50) percent of his/her time in supervision. The term "teacher" does not include principals, assistant principals, directors, substitutes, aides, nurses, clerks, department heads, or coordinators."

Further, IT IS ORDERED that the above named Public Employer shall negotiate collectively with the GILFORD EDUCATION ASSOCIATION/NEA-NH, with an objective to reaching an agreement with the employee organization on terms and conditions of employment, and shall negotiate collectively with such employee organization in the determination, and administration of, grievances.
