**ORDER** 

WHEREAS this matter was previously placed in abeyance per PELRB Decision No. 2003-089, and

WHEREAS written notification dated October 14, 2003 has been received from the representative of the Complainant stating that the parties are in agreement that this matter should continue to be held in abeyance for a period of 60 - 90 days for the purpose of allowing the parties additional time to resolve the instant dispute, or portions thereof, it is hereby:

ORDERED that this matter shall stand continued on the PELRB's docket of cases until December 15, 2003. The parties shall notify the PELRB as soon as possible in the event that they are able to reach a final settlement. On or before December 15, 2003 the Union representative shall file a status of negotiations and arbitration report with the PELRB and provide a copy of same to the State's representative. The Union representative shall also file a copy of the arbitrator's pending decision with the PELRB within five (5) days of its receipt. Unless either party has filed a request for a hearing with the PELRB within thirty (30) days of the date of the arbitrator's decision, this matter shall be administratively dismissed.
